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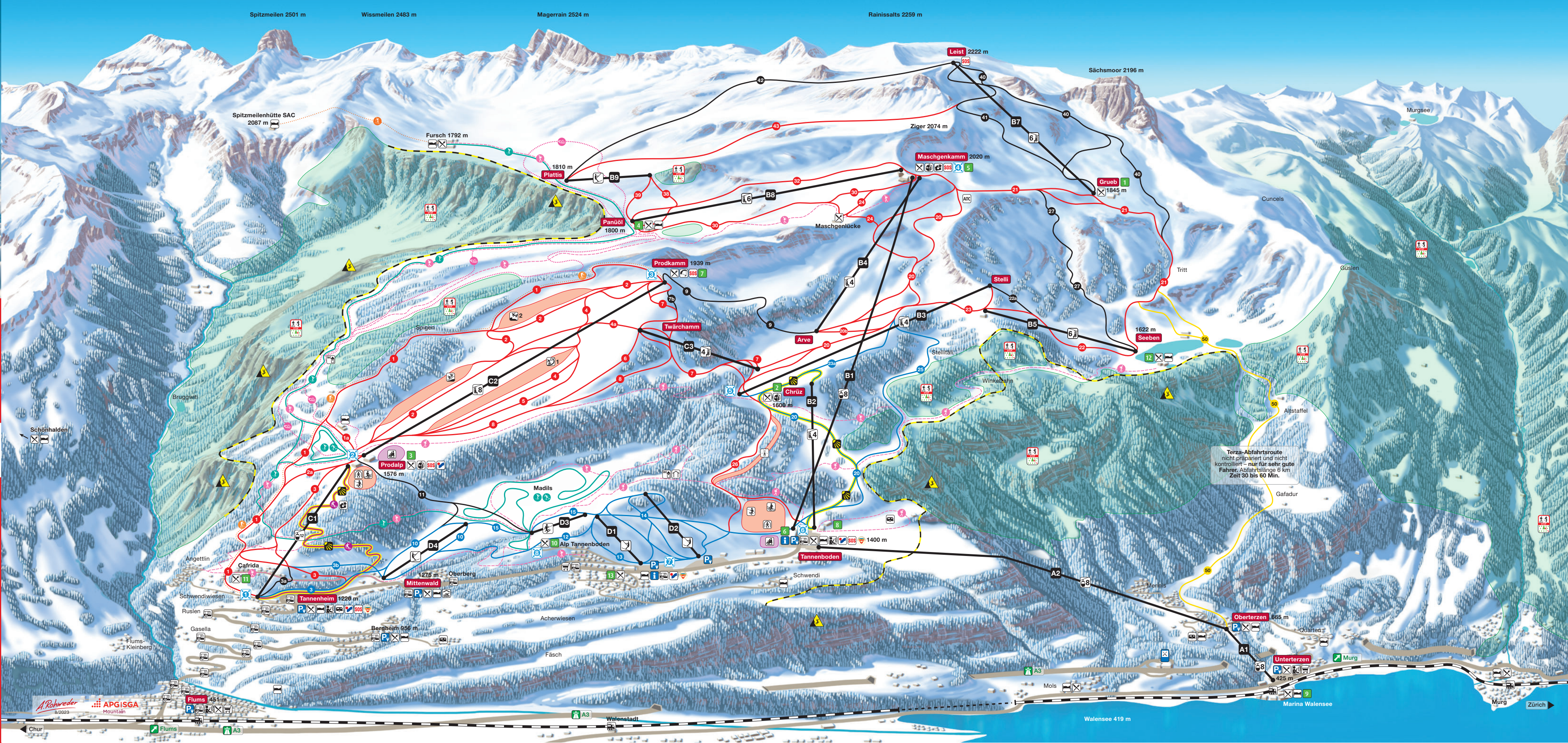
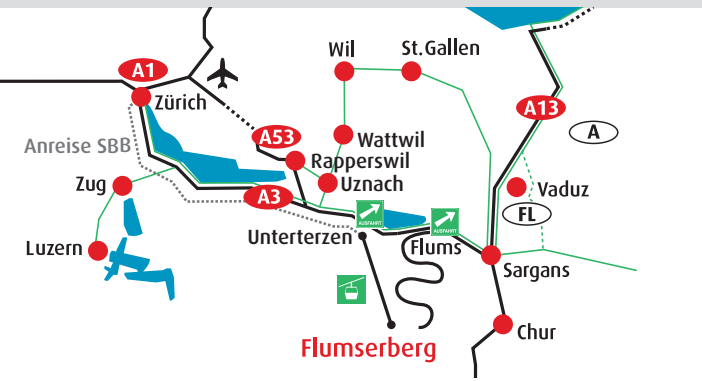
## From home directly onto the slopes

Your SwissPass  
is also a ski pass.

**S-Bahn:** Flumserberg is the only winter sports region that can be reached by urban railway (S-Bahn). At weekends and on public holidays, the S2 runs every hour from Zurich Airport to Unterterzen. The S17 from Rapperswil and Sargans also stops every hour. From St. Gallen, the S4 has a direct connection to the new S17 in Uznach. More about the S-Bahn connection: [www.sbb.ch](http://www.sbb.ch)

**Postauto:** From Sargans station, the post bus takes you via Flums into the winter sports area. An even more convenient way to get to the ski slopes and then back home again.

## Rules of behaviour

Please respect the FIS rules, signals and barriers. The piste and rescue service only monitors and controls marked and open pistes and runs. Bergbahnen Flumserberg expressly disclaims any liability. For safety reasons, the slopes may neither be walked on by pedestrians nor used by sledges.

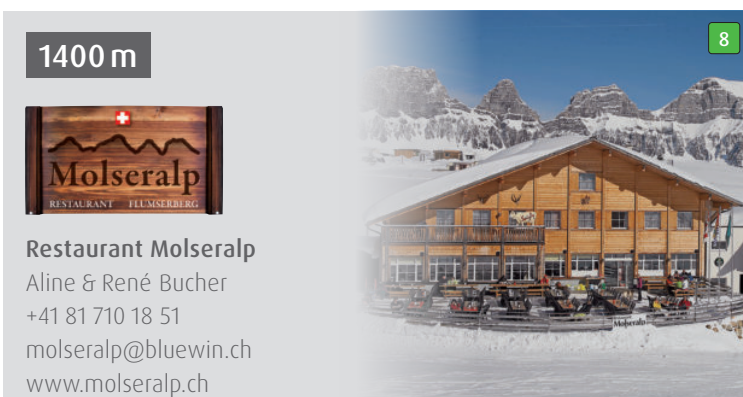
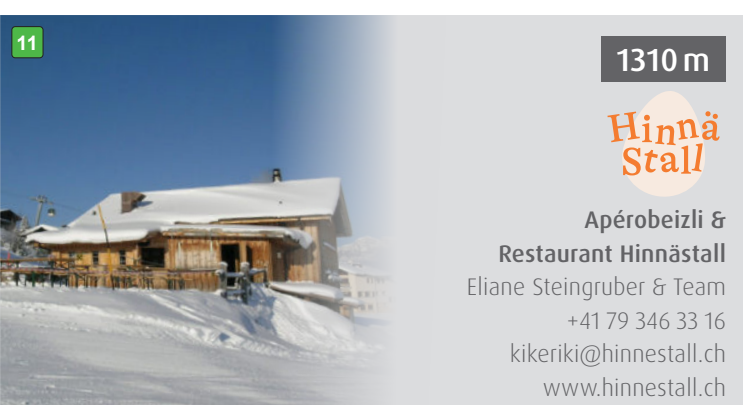
Outside the railway operating hours, the pistes and runs are closed and not protected from any hazards such as avalanche dispersion or piste machines with cable winches or tillers.

**Danger to life and limb!**  
Note the times of the last piste check. It is forbidden to use pistes and runs that are closed or barred.

It is forbidden to drive or walk in the wildlife quiet zones marked in green. Violators will be fined and have their ticket taken away in accordance with the general terms and conditions.

**What should I do in the event of an accident?**  
Contact the nearest lift or railway station or contact the SOS number +41 720 15 19. Be as precise as you can about the location of the person who had the accident.

A fee is charged for the rescue of winter sports enthusiasts who have had an accident. Searches are also subject to a fee and are at the expense of the person being searched.

## Sledging fun

**Prodalp-Tannenheim sledging run**

Race down our exciting sledging run into the valley and feel the snow blowing on your face – great fun for young and old. The sledges for this adventure can be hired on site. This sledging run is moderate and not suitable for small children, dogs are not allowed.

**Sledge transport**

Sledges can be carried on the following lifts: gondola Seejet and Prodalp-Express; on the gondola Berglet and chairlift Panüöl only for small children.

**Attractive choice of trails for cross-country skiers**

Our trails (classic and skating) take you through idyllic scenery and snowy woods at over 1400 m above sea level. They promise a unique view of the surrounding mountains. At the restaurant Sennastube, there are changing rooms, toilets, cloak-rooms and a heated waxing room available for cross-country skiers free of charge. Tickets can be purchased on site. The sportshops in Tannenheim and Tannenboden provide you with the suitable rental equipment.

...at day time from 08.00 – 17.00 hrs

Ski touring ascends on Flumserberg are allowed on the marked (signpost) and prepared Spiga-slope Nr.1. People have to ascend behind one another alongside the slope. Skiing operations need to be respected at all times. All the slopes (incl. Nr.1) are closed outside operation hours.

...at nighttime Thu, Fri, Sat until 21.00 hrs

The Spiga-slope Nr.1 and the mountain inn Prodkamm are officially open every Thursday, Friday and Saturday until 21.00 hrs. In order to guarantee your safety, the ascents and descents have to be accomplished with switched on headlamps and only on the marked Spiga-slope Nr.1.

Ascents and descents at one's own risk and responsibility. Danger through winches and avalanches blasting!
